Jay Simecka, County Sheriff, gave a report on the Sheriff's Office. Discussion was held regarding the Sheriff's Office storage area in the downstairs of the courthouse.

Commissioner Kohler (Barber) moved to approve a donation to the Chapter JN P.E.O. for Daddy Daughter Date Night in the amount of \$500.00. Funds are to be paid from the Diversion Fund. Motion carried.

Commissioner Kohler (Barber) moved to approve the invoice from Drury Inn Hotel in the amount of \$266.03, for room reservations for the Sheriff's Office while attending training. Funds are to be paid from the Diversion Fund. Motion carried.

Julie Hower discussed the Morris County Fair Board's plans to move forward with the design of the fair ground entrance sign.

Jeff Blosser, County Road Engineer, gave the following weekly road and bridge report:

- > Hauled the new crushed 1 ½ inch rock from the shop to R Ave., west of the Lake Rd.
- > Completed ditching and rebuilding CC Ave., from the Dunlap Rd. east to the county line
- > Hauled Lincolnville rock on 2800 Rd., from DD Ave. to BB Ave.
- > Hauling Lincolnville rock on AA Ave., from 2600 to 2450
- Installed a new entrance pipe on 2900 Rd. and 3100 Rd., in the Y Ave. to AA Ave. areas
