Chris Blackledge, Emergency Manager, gave a report on Emergency Management.

Jay Simecka, Sheriff, and Ben Moore, with Moore Studio LLC, discussed the Sheriff's Office/Dispatch remodel project. Potential cost savings were reviewed and will be placed as alternates when the project is put out for bid.

Commissioner Fox (Kohler) moved to proceed with the bidding process for the Sheriff's Office/Dispatch remodel. Motion carried.

Ben Moore, Moore Studio LLC, will prepare the bid specifications and the notice to bidders for publishing.
