The Morris County Commissioner meeting was called to order on Tuesday, December 6th, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. Commissioners Jim Barber, Wayne Kohler and David L. Fox were present. Chelsey Schmidt, County Clerk, and Bill Kassebaum, County Counselor, were present.

Chris Blackledge, Emergency Manager, gave a report on emergency management. The batteries for the tornado sirens were re-conditioned and are now working. The batteries will continue to be monitored and tested; it does not appear that new batteries need to be purchased. Plans continue to be on-going with local fire departments to purchase 800-mhz portable radios; funding sources are being pursued and quotes for new vs used radios are being obtained.

The commissioners scheduled the next quarterly department head meeting for January 10th at 2:00 p.m.

Commissioner Barber (Fox) moved to approve the minutes from November 29th, 2022 commission meeting, as presented. Motion carried.

Commissioner Fox (Barber) moved to approve a burn permit for Flint Hills RECA for calendar year 2023. Motion carried.

Gary Floyd discussed R Ave. from 3000-2900 Rd.; and 3100 Rd. south of 56 Hwy to U Ave. is needing more gravel, if possible.

The County Employee Policy Handbook was reviewed. Revisions to the policy will be made to the handbook and the item will be re-visited at next week's meeting. Those present were Corrine Blosser, Register of Deeds, and Ryan Michaelis, County Appraiser.

- > Shelly attended the Kansas Open Meetings Act presentation by Jay Hall
- ➤ Julie Lorenz resigned as State Secretary of Transportation and Burt Morey, State Transportation Engineer will also be leaving at the end of the year

Randy Parker discussed the area of 1800 Rd., northeast of White City. Follow up will be done with the County Appraiser to determine property lines of the gravel pile in this area.

Commissioner Fox (Barber) moved to approve payroll liabilities in the amount of \$41,387.58. Motion carried.

Commissioner Fox (Barber) moved to approve the accounts payable vouchers as presented; in the amount of \$91,778.76. Motion carried. The breakdown by fund is as follows:
