

## **January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022- Public Health Nuisance Hearing**

Chairman David Fox called the Morris County Board of Health to order to conduct a Public Nuisance Hearing at 10:05 a.m.

Those present: Commissioners David Fox, Wayne Kohler and Jim Barber, Bill Kassebaum, County Counselor, Chelsey Schmidt, County Clerk, Randy Barten, County Sanitarian, Candra Good, County Public Health Director, Billy Kryger, Chris Rhodes, Andrew Steele, Wolphen Smith and Michael Calvert.

On November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 the Morris County Board of Health had deemed the property located at 103 S 3<sup>rd</sup> St. and 114 3<sup>rd</sup> St. in Latimer to be a public health nuisance. Wolphen Smith and Michael Calvert were given 60 days to clean up the properties. Today's hearing was scheduled to review the progress being made at both locations.

Recent pictures of the property located at 103 S 3<sup>rd</sup> St. were obtained by the County Sanitarian and County Public Health Director. The pictures were reviewed and Wolphen Smith requested an extension to be granted.

Commissioner Barber (Kohler) moved to grant an extension of 84 days to allow for further clean-up of the property located at 103 S 3<sup>rd</sup> St. in Latimer. The progress will be re-evaluated on Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried.

Recent pictures of the property located at 114 3<sup>rd</sup> St. were obtained by the County Sanitarian and County Public Health Director. The pictures were reviewed and Michael Calvert requested an extension to be granted.

Commissioner Barber (Kohler) moved to grant an extension of 84 days to allow for further clean-up of the property located at 114 3<sup>rd</sup> St. in Latimer. The progress will be re-evaluated on Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried.

Commissioner Kohler (Barber) moved to adjourn as the County Board of Health at 10:18 a.m. and to re-convene as the County Commission. Motion carried.

The commission meeting was moved to the commissioner's meeting room and resumed at 10:24 a.m.
