## Others present:

Jay Simecka, County Sheriff, provided a report on the Sheriff's Office.

Jeff Blosser, County Road Director, and Shelly Lautt, County Road Assistant, gave the following weekly road and bridge report:

- Mowing on the Parkerville, east Council Grove and Dwight routes
- Completed chip sealing the Burdick Blacktops, Delavan Community Center, Council Grove streets and a portion of the Dunlap Rd. from AA to CC, down the centerline of the roadway
- Begun moving the fence on the box culvert replacement across D Ave., approximately 0.7 miles west of Hwy 4
- Grading on most of the routes
- Continue working on providing the initial information for purchasing right-of-way for the RS-60 (Dunlap River) Bridge project; following the established KDOT land acquisition procedures
- ➤ The 2023 Off-System Bridge application for the OS-32 Bridge, on H Ave. between 1800 and 1900 Rd., did not get chosen this funding cycle

Commissioner Kohler (Barber) moved to approve the purchase of two squash culverts from Welborn Sales Inc. for the box replacement on X Ave., west of 400 Rd., in the total amount of \$25,991.84. Motion carried.

Commissioner Kohler (Barber) moved to approve the minutes from the September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021 meeting. Motion carried.

Commissioner Barber (Kohler) moved to approve the accounts payable vouchers as presented; in the total amount of \$56,705.48. Motion carried. The breakdown by fund is as follows:
